Travel from the northernmost tip of the island of Newfoundland to the most easterly point in North America through national parks, including Gros Morne, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Learn of ancient peoples, including the Maritime Archaic, Vikings, and Basques, as you travel to coastal fishing communities to meet the friendly and hospitable people of today. Boat tours provide the opportunity to see whales, thousands of seabirds, and, depending on the time of year, icebergs! Sample the local food and drink to become an honorary "Newfoundlander!"

daily itinerary

- day 1* **FLIGHT FROM LOS ANGELES TO HALIFAX, NOVA SCOTIA**
Arrive in Halifax and check in at your accommodations for the night. The lovely hotel is conveniently located in the downtown core. This evening, you'll meet your fellow travelers and Tour Director at a Meet and Greet event. Depending on your arrival time, you may wish to book a Gray Line Tour of Halifax, Peggy's Cove or Lunenburg.
- day 2* **HALIFAX TO PORT AUX BASQUES, NEWFOUNDLAND (CB, D)**
Travel via Truro and Antigonish to cross over the Canso Causeway to Cape Breton Island. At North Sydney, you'll board a Marine Atlantic ferry for a relaxing crossing to Port aux Basques. This is the port of entry on the island of Newfoundland.
- day 3* **PORT AUX BASQUES TO PORT AU CHOIX, NEWFOUNDLAND (B, L, D)**
Drive through the Codroy Valley and on to Corner Brook, the largest city on the west coast. Your journey continues through Gros Morne National Park – to be enjoyed later on during your tour – to the fishing community of Port au Choix
- day 4* **PORT AU CHOIX TO L'ANSE AU CLAIR, NEWFOUNDLAND (B, D)**
Board the ferry from St. Barbe to cross the Strait of Belle Isle to Labrador. Continue to Red Bay National Historic Site (now a UNESCO World Heritage Site) where the Basques had a whaling station in the 16th century. Spend the night in Labrador.



day 5

L'ANSE AU CLAIR TO ST. ANTHONY, NEWFOUNDLAND (B, D)

Return to Newfoundland and travel to L'Anse aux Meadows National Historic Site, the first cultural discovery in the world to receive recognition as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Hear of the Vikings who walked here over a thousand years ago.

day 6

ST. ANTHONY TO COW HEAD, NEWFOUNDLAND (B, D)

Enjoy a morning whale watching boat tour in St. Anthony (weather permitting)* before traveling to Cow Head for a two-night stay.

*June and early July are the best time to see Titanic-size icebergs!

day 7

GROS MORNE NATIONAL PARK (B, L, D)

Discover why Gros Morne National Park is truly one of the highlights of your tour. You'll visit the Lobster Cove Lighthouse. Enjoy a scenic boat tour (weather permitting) as you learn the geology of the Tablelands, see bald eagles that frequent the deep waters of the fjord, and hear the history of the small villages nestled on the shores. It is an unforgettable experience; some say the scenery is unequalled in eastern Canada

day 8

COW HEAD TO GANDER, NEWFOUNDLAND (B, D)

Have your camera at the ready as your time in Gros Morne National Park draws to a close. Later travel through central Newfoundland and on to Gander where you spend two nights.

day 9

TWILLINGATE TOURING (B, L, D)

A scenic drive along the rocky coast of Notre Dame Bay leads to the beautiful outpost of Twillingate. At the tip of the island, visit Long Point Lighthouse and the local co-op. Return to Gander to visit the North Atlantic Aviation Museum before returning to your hotel.

day 10

GANDER TO CLARENVILLE, NEWFOUNDLAND (B, L)

Head out on the Trans-Canada Highway to visit Terra Nova National Park, the most easterly of Canada's beautiful national parks. Keep your camera close at hand for wildlife along the way. Learn about the hard life of light keepers at Cape Bonavista Lighthouse Provincial Historic Site. This afternoon stroll through the lanes of the charming town of Trinity where you will see several historic buildings including a typical 20th century rural merchant's house and a counting house. Later, you'll check in to your Clarenville hotel for the night.

day 11

CLARENVILLE TO ST. JOHN'S, NEWFOUNDLAND (B, D)

Arrive in the capital city of St. John's for a two-night stay. Enjoy an intriguing tour of this old seaport. See the Victorian architecture of the downtown area, the busy modern waterfront, the Cathedral of St. John the Baptist, Confederation Building, and the panoramic view from Signal Hill National Historic Site.

day 12

TOURING IN ST. JOHN'S (B)

This morning, travel to Bay Bulls for one of the highlights of your trip -- a boat tour to the Witless Bay Bird Sanctuary (weather permitting). Later visit the most easterly point in North America, Cape Spear National Historic Site. The remainder of the day is free to explore on your own.

day 13

HOMeward BOUND (B)

Depart St. John's for your flight back home.
