“Leonardo DaVinci’s Machines and Art” features full-scale and scaled models of DaVinci’s inventions and machines.

Highlights of the exhibit include the Great Kite, which is considered his "definitive" flying machine, as well as the world's first working prototype of his Self-Propelled Cart, and the first physical models of his Mechanical Bat and Mechanical Lion, among others.

Leonardo Da Vinci was well known for his artworks and this exhibit features the Last Supper, the Mona Lisa and the presumed Self-Portrait, amongst others. Each of these works are presented using the innovative technology of the L3 HyperView software which offers a unique way to interact with the paintings of the master (The visitor is able to zoom in on the work in greater detail).

The exhibit is all replicas and recreations.
