The St. Matthew Passion (German: Matthäus-Passion), BWV 244, is widely regarded as one of the masterpieces of Baroque music. Written in 1727 by Bach for performances in his Leipzig St. Thomas Church, it is scored for two groups of vocalists and double orchestra. It sets parts of the Gospel of Matthew to music, told by the Evangelist (Tenor) in dialogue with Jesus (Baritone) and with interspersed chorales and arias. Martin Haselböck and Musica Angelica toured the piece in 2007 with 14 acclaimed performances in Mexico City, Pasadena, New York, Savannah, Vienna, Budapest, Madrid, Munich, Baden-Baden, and Merano. With a cast of wonderful American and European Vocal soloists, Musica Angelica will perform this perennial masterwork in one of the most beautiful Los Angeles churches to create atmosphere and spirit for a musical experience not to forget.
