Opened in 1935, at the time it was the largest building in the western U.S. and served as a daily newspaper publishing operation. After touring the Times building, you'll be treated to lunch at **Philippe The Original**, one of the oldest and best-known restaurants in Southern California! Established in 1908, **Philippe's** claims the distinction of having created the "French Dipped Sandwich." After lunch you're off to tour the Los Angeles Police Museum. Always exciting, frequently controversial, the history of the LAPD greatly influences the history of the City of Los Angeles and its law enforcement. You'll hear facts and see artifacts pertaining to the department's history, as you are led by a volunteer through this fascinating museum.

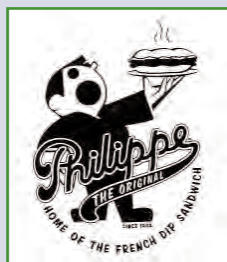
