

# MEET THE NIXONS

**M**ee**t the Nixons** on this fascinating tour! Richard Nixon, our 37th President, came from humble beginnings. Born in Yorba Linda in 1913, he moved to Whittier when he was 9 years old and spent most of his formative years there. On a **guided tour of Whittier**, you'll get an inside look into Nixon's early years. You'll learn of the small grocery store his family ran, see the high school he attended, as well as other points of interest pertaining to his life and upbringing. You'll also visit the **Whittier Museum** where you'll see exhibits about Nixon's life and enjoy **lunch at the Vintage Cafe in Uptown Whittier**. After lunch, you'll travel to Yorba Linda to spend the afternoon learning about his years as President of the United States. The **Richard Nixon Presidential Library** opened its doors in 1990 at the site of the birth and resting place of America's 37th President. Admirers, as well as the not-so-adoring, of the late president should be equally rewarded by a visit to the museum. Built around Nixon's boyhood home, the library is a treasure trove for political junkies. It houses an extensive Watergate exhibit, and displays a number of popular items including the gun that Elvis Presley presented to Nixon in the Oval Office. The nine acres of library grounds include the home where America's 37th president was born. The **First Lady's Rose Garden**, which is the largest rose garden in Orange County, pays tribute to Pat Nixon's love for gardens. Just beyond the rose garden lies the flower ringed burial sites of President and Mrs. Nixon. **Special rotating exhibits are featured throughout the year giving repeat visitors a new occasion to return to the Library.**
