GOOD AND EVIL GUIDED TOUR IN LOS ANGELES WITH LUNCH AT THE GALLEY

The real Los Angeles does not fit neatly into the category of "American" city. It is an old western town that was lawless; settled by thieves, prostitutes, and the other criminally disposed. It is also religious and pious with grand churches and adobe missions. This is the place where God and the Devil shook hands so the party could go on. On this tour we take you through the sweat-soaked madness of our best and worst. Curt Tucker joins us for the day telling sordid tales of intrigue and tragedy. In historic Rancho Santa Anita, we'll visit Elias Jackson ("Lucky") Baldwin's Queen Anne Cottage. Lucky turned Rancho Santa Anita into a tremendously productive operation, replete with thoroughbred race studs and miles of orchards and vineyards. Through it all, his penchant for business and love affairs kept his name in the papers for years to come, transfixing Americans with tales of immorality. Blink and you may miss this rustic pioneer Savannah Pioneer Cemetery. By street view it almost looks like an ordinary park. But a closer inspection reveals history hidden in plain sight. For lunch we will come aboard Clearman's Galley for a rousing good time and great food. "The Boat" is known for their famous cheese bread and red cabbage salad as well as their classic fish and chips, hamburgers, sandwiches, chicken dinners, and more! After lunch we will visit the Los Angeles Police Museum, featuring engaging exhibits and rare timeless artifacts inside the city's oldest surviving police station. Next, we'll tour the Foursquare Heritage Center, home to evangelist Aimee Semple McPherson, one of the most famous and influential people of the 1920s. We'll also visit the historic Angelus Temple, the colossal house of worship crowned with a silver-painted dome that opened in 1923 under McPherson's leadership. And finally, we will see the Cathedral of Our Lady of the Angels. This fascinating Cathedral, with its sleek postmodern design, contains Relics of a 3rd-century Roman martyr, an impressive organ, beautiful tapestries, and glorious stained-glass windows.
