THE HOLYLAND EXHIBITION

You'll be taken on a guided tour of this home and museum dedicated to Antonia Futterer, an eclectic adventurer who some say was the inspiration for the character, Indiana Jones. His love for the Holyland and the preservation of its ancient past led to a number of expeditions in search of the Golden Ark of the Covenant. It was never discovered; however, he amassed an incredible collection that has been on display since 1924.

VALLEY RELICS MUSEUM

Explore this vast collection of artifacts and memorabilia from matchbooks and postcards to vintage neon signs and cars. The Valley Relics Museum is the creation of San Fernando Valley native Tommy Gelinis, who serves as the lone curator of the collection.
