## DAILY ITINERARY

### DAY 1 TRAVEL ROUTE 66 TO WILLIAMS, ARIZONA (D)

Meet our tour director and driver as we set out on our spectacular seven day adventure to the great Southwest. Today is a travel day that takes us along part of Route 66 from California to Arizona. Enroute, we'll play some Bingo, watch a movie or two and get to know one another. Upon arrival into Williams, we'll take a drive through Bearizona Wildlife Park before checking in to our classic Route 66 accommodations. A fun welcome dinner is planned for this evening at Miss Kitty's Steak House.

### DAY 2 MONUMENT VALLEY AND DURANGO, COLORADO (B, L, D)

Breakfast this morning is at Wild West Junction before we depart Williams and start heading toward Durango. We'll stop off along the way at an Indian Trading Post and have lunch at Goulding's Lodge in the heart of Monument Valley. From Monument Valley, we'll continue traveling east into Southern Colorado, home of the historic western town of Durango. We'll check in for a two-night stay at the Hampton Inn, followed by dinner at the popular Palace Restaurant in downtown Durango.

### DAY 3 DURANGO & SILVERTON NARROW GAUGE RAILROAD (B)

After breakfast at the hotel (included), we'll head over to the train station to board the Durango & Silverton Narrow Gauge Railroad for a memorable train ride through the Southern Colorado Rockies. This historic train has been in continuous operation between Durango and Silverton since 1882, carrying passengers behind vintage steam locomotives and rolling stock indigenous to the line. It offers a view of Colorado's mountain splendor, inaccessible by highway. You'll relive the sights and sounds of yesteryear for a spectacular journey aboard the railroad that Sunset Magazine calls "the best train experience!" Upon arrival into the station in Silverton, you'll have time for lunch and shopping in this charming Western town before returning to Durango aboard our motorcoach. The remainder of the afternoon and evening are free to discover all that Durango has to offer. Your tour director will be on hand to offer suggestions for dining this evening.

### DAY 4 PAGOSA SPRINGS, SANTA FE AND ALBUQUERQUE, NEW MEXICO (B, D)

Breakfast is included again at the hotel before checking out and traveling to Pagosa Springs, Colorado. Get ready for some fun and relaxation as we spend the morning enjoying the 18 different pools at The Springs Resort & Spa. The soaking pools offer a range of temperatures for you to discover your unique soaking and healing experience. The "Great Pagosa Spring" which feeds mineral water to the 18 soaking pools, is the Guinness World Record title holder of The World's Deepest Geothermal Hot Spring. Locker and towel rental is included during your visit to the hot springs. Later we'll travel to Santa Fe where you'll have several hours to explore this magical, exuberant and colorful city. You'll discover art galleries, museums, authentic Southwestern cuisine and colorful markets that have made Santa Fe a legendary trading center for hundreds of years. After visiting Santa Fe, we'll continue our trek south into the city of Albuquerque, known as the "Land of Enchantment," beneath painted skies commonly filled with hot air balloons. A traditional New Mexican dinner at Albuquerque's famous El Pinto Restaurant is included before bedding down for the night at an Albuquerque hotel.

### DAY 5 PETRIFIED FOREST AND SEDONA, ARIZONA (B, L, D)

After breakfast at your hotel (included), we'll check out and travel west along Route 66 toward Arizona. We'll stop off in Gallup, New Mexico, for a fun lunch at historic Route 66 hotel before traveling on to the Petrified Forest National Park. Located in the Painted Desert, the Petrified Forest is home to the world's largest collection of brilliantly colored petrified wood remaining in its natural setting. After touring the park, we'll continue our journey west as we travel through spectacular Oak Creek Canyon and into Sedona, Arizona. Sedona is in the heart of a magical, mystical region surrounded by multi-hued stone formations that jut upwards from the high desert floor creating a vivid, mesmerizing setting that changes hourly with the light. When USA Weekend compiled their Most Beautiful Places in America list, Sedona claimed the top spot. We'll check in to our Sedona hotel for a relaxing two night stay. Dinner this evening is included at Sedona's popular Tlaquepaque Arts & Crafts Village.

### DAY 6 EXPLORE SEDONA BY TROLLEY AND PINK JEEPS (B, D)

Breakfast is included at the hotel before we set out to experience all that Sedona has to offer! First, we'll take a guided trolley tour that showcases the upscale Gallery District, including the famous Tlaquepaque Arts & Crafts Village, and is highlighted by a 15 to 20 minute stop at the inspirational Chapel of the Holy Cross. The views from the chapel are spectacular. Upon returning to town, you'll have time for lunch and shopping for Southwestern and Native American crafts. The fun really kicks into high gear this evening as you climb aboard a custom-built, open-air Pink® Jeep® Wrangler for a scenic tour of the surrounding area. Experience views that will leave you breathless as you escape to the trails of Sedona's open range on this mild excursion. Inspiring red rock formations are the backdrop for this panoramic adventure. Your knowledgeable driver guide will introduce you to the local plant life, wildlife and geological history of this beautiful region. Photo ops are plentiful and feature some of Arizona's most stunning scenery as your backdrop. And there's no better time to witness this than the early evening as the sun begins to set. A special farewell dinner is included in Sedona.

### DAY 7 HOMEWARD BOUND VIA PHOENIX (B, L)

One last breakfast is included at the hotel before boarding our coach for the final leg of our weeklong adventure. We'll travel by way of Phoenix and stop off at Rustler's Rooste for a fun lunch before making the final trek back to California.
