### CAMP PENDLETON RANCH HOUSE TOUR

The 8,500 square foot Santa Margarita y Las Flores Ranch House (circa 1827) was and remains the center of ranch and Marine Corps Base life. This magnificent building is a stunning example of early ranch architecture in California. It is listed on the National Register of Historic Sites and once was the home of Pio Pico, the last governor of Mexican California. You'll tour the ranch with a docent and also visit the beautiful chapel.
