DAILY ITINERARY

DAY 1 FLIGHT TO NEW YORK (D)

Your adventure begins with a cross country flight from Los Angeles to New York City (JFK, Newark or LaGuardia). Upon arrival, our licensed NYC guide will greet you and escort you by luxury motorcoach to your hotel. The Millennium Broadway is your 4-star home for the next four nights. Ideally located in Times Square, you will be within walking distance to all the Broadway shows, Rockefeller Center, and Fifth Avenue. A fun welcome dinner is planned at famous Carmine's restaurant. This lively and festive restaurant serves delicious Italian fare, family-style.

DAY 2 MIDTOWN TOUR AND A BROADWAY SHOW (B)

After breakfast at the hotel, you'll set out to spend the day exploring Midtown Manhattan. It begins with an "Up Close and Personal" session. In a true Broadway rehearsal room, an actor from a show you will be seeing will stop by and discuss their life on Broadway, their career and perform a number or two from the show. Next stop is Rockefeller Center where you'll see the art-deco architecture and artwork and ride the elevator up 70 floors to the Top of the Rock. This indoor/outdoor observation deck boasts magnificent views of the entire city, the Hudson River and New Jersey. It also has the very best view of the Empire State Building. Later, you'll head over to Radio City Music Hall, home of the Rockettes, where you'll embark on a fascinating backstage guided tour and have an opportunity to meet a Rockette! The afternoon includes a stroll down Fifth Avenue, a peek inside St. Patrick's Cathedral and Grand Central Terminal, and a drive by the United Nations. Dinner is on your own before you take a seat in one of Broadway's famous theatres for a show (orchestra seating).

DAY 3 ELLIS ISLAND, THE STATUE OF LIBERTY, THE 9/11 MEMORIAL AND MORE (B)

Breakfast is included again at the hotel before meeting our guide for another day of touring in the Big Apple. First you will head down to Battery Park to hop on the Statue of Liberty ferry. You will be taken to both Liberty Island and Ellis Island where you'll have an audio headset to tour at your own pace. Back on Manhattan Island, you'll have lunch on your own at one of New York's famous delis, then head over to the World Trade Center. Our guide will help round out the stories of 9/11, the heroes and the incredible transformation. The National 9/11 Memorial covers the footprint of Towers 1 and 2 and is a moving experience to witness firsthand. You will also have admission to the National 9/11 Museum. On your way back uptown, you will travel by Little Italy, Chinatown and stop in Greenwich Village for pastry and coffee at Rocco's family-owned Italian bakery. You'll also have some time to stroll the quaint streets of this quiet New York neighborhood. The evening is free to take in another Broadway show, check out the cuisine scene or just enjoy the big city vibe in Times Square.

DAY 4 CENTRAL PARK AND TOURING IN UPTOWN (B, D)

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before meeting our guide for a tour of Uptown. We'll start in Central Park which is a major part of New Yorkers' lifestyle. You'll take a stroll with our guide before climbing aboard a horse and carriage for a classic ride through the park. From there, you'll continue on to Harlem which has gone through several historic renaissances, and today you will see the current revitalization of this important neighborhood. From 125th to Morningside Heights to the Apollo Theater, the famous folks that have lived and worked here are etched into our culture. The day rounds out with a stop at Cathedral St. John's the Divine, the largest cathedral in North America. A special farewell dinner is planned at Rock Center Cafe in the heart of Rockefeller Center.

DAY 5 HOMEWARD BOUND (B)

After breakfast, you'll have some time for last-minute shopping and exploring before returning to the airport for our flight home.
